Parent Education Courses for Parents of Kindergarten and Primary Students (2022/23 School Year)

Summary

This circular memorandum informs kindergartens (including kindergarten-cum-child care centres and schools with kindergarten classes) and primary schools (including special schools) of the parent education courses provided by the Education Bureau (EDB) in the 2022/23 school year. Schools are invited to forward this circular memorandum to the Parent-Teacher Associations, teachers and parents to encourage parents' participation.

Background

2. EDB has all along been supporting home-school co-operation, forging home-school partnership and promoting parent education through kindergartens as well as primary and secondary schools (including special schools). The Education Commission set up the Task Force on Home-School Co-operation and Parent Education (Task Force) and submitted a report to EDB in April 2019. One of the recommendations is to develop a curriculum framework or curriculum guide on parent education in order to meet the needs of parents at each stage, and equip them with the necessary knowledge and skills for bringing up their children at different stages. In accordance with the recommendations of the Task Force. EDB launched the Curriculum Framework on Parent Education (Kindergarten) and the Curriculum Framework on Parent Education (Primary School) in September 2021 and December 2022 respectively. The curriculum frameworks comprise four core strands: "Understanding of Child Development", "Promotion of Health, Happy and Balanced Development of Children", "Promotion of Parents' Physical and Psychological Well-being" and "Fostering Home-school Co-operation and Communication". The curriculum frameworks serve as common basis for relevant institutions, groups or organisations to provide systematic parent education courses with different objectives across stages through organising territory-wide, community-based, school-based and online parent education courses.

Details

3. Parents are key partners of schools and play a pivotal role in supporting students' learning, fostering their positive values and whole-person development. Parents are encouraged to learn age-appropriate parenting knowledge and skills, and to be positive role models for their children. By acquiring parenting knowledge and skills, parents could have a better understanding of their children's uniqueness and characteristics so as to set reasonable expectations for themselves and their children, and enhance family relationship and the well-being of their children and themselves.

4. To enhance parents' relevant knowledge and skills and help them develop a positive attitude towards parenting, EDB has commissioned the School of Continuing Education of Hong Kong Baptist University to conduct parent education courses for parents of kindergarten students and parents of primary students respectively. The courses will make reference to the Curriculum Framework on Parent Education (Kindergarten) and Curriculum Framework on Parent Education (Primary School), covering the key issues relating to different domains of parent education. Through a variety of learning activities, such as lectures, experience sharing, role plays and round-table discussion, the courses help parents master the relevant knowledge and skills so as to facilitate children's healthy growth and effective learning.

5. The parent education courses will be conducted from **June to July 2023**. Details of the courses and enrolment methods are set out at <u>Annex</u> and the Parent Education Activity Information Hub of the "Smart Parent Net" website of EDB. Schools are invited to inform parents of the courses through various means (such as school webpage, school circular, e-mail, parents' messaging group and Parent-Teacher Association) and encourage them to enrol. **The enrolment deadlines are 15 May 2023 (for kindergarten level) and 17 May 2023 (for primary level) respectively**.
